In late August 2021, The Standing Committee of the National People's Congress passed the Personal Information Protection Law, which is among the strictest data laws in the world.



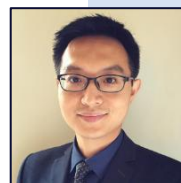
